### NOTICE OF RACE 2018 Dillon Yacht Club Summer Series Lake Dillon, Colorado

You are cordially invited to participate in the 2018 Dillon Yacht Club (DYC) Summer Series, a series of 6 named weekend regattas to be held starting June 9, 2018 and concluding September 16, 2018. Dillon Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority (OA).

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the rules as defined in The *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2017-2020.
- 1.2 The following Racing Rules will be changed as follows:
  - RRS Appendix A2: Scoring, See Section 10.
  - RRS Appendix A11: Abbreviations, See Section 13.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Races are open to all members of the Dillon Yacht Club
- 2.2 DYC members intending to compete in the Summer Series must pay race fees before the first scheduled race (see 9.3) in order to qualify for inclusion in the series scoring. Paying racing fees, signing liability release and filling out registration form constitutes registering for Summer Series.
- 2.3 Boats may enter individual weekend regattas by completing the entry form, signing the liability release and paying fee by 11:30 AM of the day they wish to compete. Forms are to be submitted at Yacht Club office.
- 2.4 All boats competing must display the mainsail number identical to the number they registered with, or report to the RC a change in sail number PRIOR to the start of racing that day.
- 2.5 For all boats competing in the Summer Series, the skipper must be a full member of the Dillon Yacht Club.
- 2.6 It is the boat owner's responsibility to carry liability and casualty insurance to cover all potential and actual claims and losses and to provide proof on request of the OA.

#### 3. CLASSES

- 3.1 Three or more one-design boats registered and paid in the Summer Series will constitute a Fleet for scoring purposes. Any registered boat must compete in at least one race of the Summer Series to be included in the fleet.
- 3.2 Any class with less than three boats may race in the PHRF fleet.

3.3 If a boat does not have a SAIL PHRF rating certificate, the Organizing Authority will assign a rating to that boat.

#### 4. FEES

##### 4.1 Racing Fees:

Summer Series (includes Frostbite Series)	\$275
Individual Regattas	\$70
Individual Race Days	\$35

#### 5. SCHEDULE

5.1 A competitors' meeting will be held on June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 11:30 AM. A competitors' meeting may be held on the Saturday of each successive race weekend at 11:30 AM. Meetings will be held at the tent next to the yacht club.

##### 5.2 Dates of racing

June 9-10	Peak 1 Regatta	1 PM Warning

August 18-19	Peak 7 Regatta	1 PM Warning

September 15-16	Changing of the Colors Regatta	1 PM Warning

5.3 Eight races are scheduled for each weekend. Races will be sailed back to back. One race constitutes a series.

5.4 The scheduled warning time for the first race each day is 1:00 PM

5.5 No race will be started after 6:00 PM on Saturdays and 5:00 PM on Sundays.

#### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing instructions will be available online at [www.dillonyachtclub.com](http://www.dillonyachtclub.com) and at the Yacht Club before the first race.

#### 7. VENUE

7.1 All races will be held on Dillon Reservoir.

#### 8. COURSES

8.1 Racing marks will be permanently set numbered marks. The RC shall post the course on a white board using the mark numbers in the order to be rounded. A map of the lake and the approximate location of the marks will be available at the Yacht Club before the first competitors meeting.

## 9. SCORING

9.1 Races will be scored according to RRS A2 with the following modification to A2.1: There will be one score excluded for every 6 races scored.

9.2 PHRF scoring will use the Sailing Association of Intermountain Lake PHRF time on time correction using the formula:

$$\text{Corrected time} = 715 / (515 + \text{PHRF Handicap}) \times \text{Elapsed time.}$$

9.3 A boat will not be scored for any races before its racing fees are paid.

## 10. PRIZES

10.1 DYC Summer Series prizes for the top 3 finishing boats in each fleet (see 3) will be awarded by the OA at the DYC Awards Banquet.

10.2 Results for the weekend for each fleet will be recognized after racing each Sunday.

## 11. COMMUNICATIONS

11.1 RC will monitor VHF channel 69 for all communications

## 12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after any race of the series. See RRS 4 Decision to Race.

Before the first race of the Summer Series each skipper is responsible for the skipper and the crew to sign a waiver of liability, available at the first competitors' meeting or at the yacht club.

## 13. SERIES RACE COMMITTEE DUTIES

13.1 PRO's have been assigned for each of the 6 weekend regattas.

13.2 The OA will assign weekends for each fleet to provide 4 people to support RC. It is the responsibility of the Fleet captains to make these arrangements.

13.3 Any boat unable to race as a result of Race Committee duties will receive their average Series score for each race missed. This will change RRS A11 adding an abbreviation RC to designate average score.
